

Enrolments at the Medical Centre – The Havelock Medical Centre has been fully open for enrolments since June/July 2019, and since that time there had been 750 new enrolments, at Havelock and Springlands. Those new to the area can have an immediate enrolment
Those who wish to transfer from another Marlborough Practice will go on the waitlist for enrolment. This is because they do already have a doctor, so those without a doctor will be ahead of them on the waitlist. However currently that waitlist is only 3 weeks

Patient Portal – Springlands Medical Centre (and therefore Havelock Medical Centre) has signed up to the national patient portal system- Health 365. You can now manage your health online. With this service you can:

- *Make appointments with your GP or nurse
- *Access your medical records
- *Access the consultation notes your doctor makes
- *Order repeat prescriptions
- *Track your lab/test results
- *Get a list of scheduled events, e.g. due dates for checkups, follow up care etc

To sign up, grab an enrolment form from Havelock Medical Centre or the Havelock Charity Shop. Fill it in and bring it to the medical centre. Note: If you only have one email address for a couple, you will need to sign confidentiality agreements. It is better to have separate email addresses.
